*To dispose of paint (oil-based and latex) remove lids, add mulch, sand or kitty litter to speed the drying process. Once paint is completely dried out, it can be disposed of in regular trash. You can also purchase waste paint hardener, which is available at many paint and home improvement stores.

**Vehicle batteries, motor oil and antifreeze are not accepted at this event since these items may be recycled at the Frederick County Recycling Center at 9031 Reichs Ford Road during normal Landfill operating hours, 7am – 4:30pm, Monday through Saturday.
